


SIRS In-Person Poster Printing and Mounting Guidelines



The maximum poster size is .90 meters wide by 1.20 meters tall (or approximately 2.75 feet wide by 3.75 feet tall)

- Posters should be adhered with mounting putty/sticky tack (<u>not</u> double-sided tape). A small amount of tack will be provided, but it is recommended that presenters bring their own if possible. (Example image below.)
- Place the poster title at the top of the poster in large letters.
- Please indicate the presenting author in the author block (bold, underline, asterisk, etc.).
- All disclosures relevant to this study must be listed on the poster.
- Remember, illustrations may be read by interested scientists from distances of about 1 meter or more. Keep them simple. Charts, drawings, and illustrations should be large.
- Do not mount materials on heavy board because it will be difficult to affix the materials to the poster board. Keep presentation as lightweight as possible.



- Presenters will be able to mount their poster the morning of their scheduled poster presentation.
- Each poster board will have a number in the top left corner of the board. Please do not cover the poster number when mounting your poster.
- Presenters will be required to take down their poster immediately following the poster session.

Poster Printing in Florence

(Poster Size is .90 meters wide by 1.20 meters tall)

There are two options for printing in Florence:

Presenters can order a printed poster in two size/price options from ssd_lab (the official printer of the Congress Center). Posters ordered through ssd_lab will be delivered to the SIRS Registration Desk for pickup. Posters must be ordered by Monday, April 4 2022 to be delivered by the poster sessions.

For another option, there is a printer near the conference venue that can print scientific posters in the required dimensions, *however*, please note the hours of operation below. The printer is <u>closed on Saturday and Sunday</u>. If your poster is scheduled for presentation on Saturday, you would have to pick your poster up Friday, 8 April during their operating hours. Please also note that they are closed for a two-hour period midday through the week. Please consider the available pick-up times before making a decision to print in Florence (as other printing companies would also be closed on the weekend). Tecnicopia **DOES NOT** deliver to the Congress center.
