Travel Award Applications

Deadline: Monday, October 18, 2021

- There are two types of travel awards:
 - (1) for graduate or medical students who are currently enrolled in PhD, MD, or MD/PhD programs
 - (1) for postdoctoral fellows/medical residents/junior faculty
 - For the postdoc/resident/junior faculty level award, applicants must be within 5 years of completing postdoctoral or residency training. Applicants may have a career development award (K-type) but not yet a R-level grant.
- You will be asked to upload:
 - Your CV or NIH bio sketch
 - A half-page career statement and explanation of why this travel award would be beneficial for you (PDF)
 - One letter of recommendation that also confirms your eligibility (*for graduate/medical student award, currently enrolled in PhD, MD, or MD/PhD program; for postdoc/resident/junior faculty award, currently a postdoctoral fellow or resident, or within 5 years of completing training*). Preference will be given to those presenting a symposium talk or poster at the meeting. (PDF)
- Only young investigators receiving the awards will be notified in mid-November 2021. Awards for both types are for \$1,500. Part of the monies must be used to register for the meeting.

- Select the travel award type and upload the documents needed.
