Nomination Instructions for the Theodore Reich Early Career Award
Submission Deadline: Thursday, May 14, 2026

To submit your nomination, please follow the instructions below:

1. Visit the 2026 Abstract Submission Portal by going to: ispg.societyconference.com and select “Log-In”.
2. Go to Submissions and select “Access My Dashboard”.
3. Select the large blue square “Submit ISPG Awards Nomination”.
4. Under “ISPG Award Nomination” select “Theodore Reich Early Career Award” in the drop-down menu. You will then be directed to the submission application.

* Candidates are required to be current members of ISPG and must have completed their formal training (i.e., terminal degree, post-PhD fellowship or post-doctoral fellowship, medical residency, or other specialized training) within the past ten years. Steps for Submission:

Theodore Reich Early Career Award Questions

1. Task 1 (Nominee Information): Search for the ISPG member you are nominating for the award.
2. Task 2 (Year of Completion of Training): Enter the year the nominee completed training.
3. Task 3 (Scientific Work and Achievements): Write a brief (1,000 word max) description of the scientific work and achievements justifying why the proposed scientist is eligible for the Theodore Reich Young Investigator Award.
4. Task 4 (Current CV): Upload a current 4-page CV that includes a full list of at least FIVE (5) publications and descriptions.
