

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

You are invited to participate in the Annual Meeting of the American Society of Clinical Psychopharmacology (ASCP) to be held at the Fairmont Scottsdale Princess on May 27 – 30, 2025, by submitting a proposal and attending the meeting. The committee welcomes submissions from the U.S. as well as international proposals, and this year the committee strongly encourages the composition of panels and workshops that include women, under-represented minorities and early career scientists and clinicians.

This year's meeting theme is

Navigating the Evolution of Clinical Psychiatry: When is Newer Better?

We have entered a period of novel treatments entering our therapeutic pipeline and with several more on the horizon, including novel pharmacological, neuromodulation, and digital health interventions. The Program Committee for the Annual Meeting is particularly interested in proposals addressing how as researchers, clinicians and educators we can identify when, how, and for whom these new therapeutic options are effective.
