The Donald Klein Lifetime Achievement Award honors an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the field of clinical psychopharmacology. The recipient will receive a **\$1,000 stipend upon mandatory attendance and presentation of a lecture at the 2026 ASCP Annual Meeting.**

This award celebrates the legacy of Dr. Donald Klein, a pioneer whose research and clinical insights transformed the understanding and treatment of anxiety, mood disorders, and psychotic illnesses, and who helped shape the structure of modern clinical trials.

- ✓ Recipient who has made an outstanding contribution to the clinical psychopharmacology field
- ✓ Age 70+ or achieved academic "emeritus" status
- ✓ Full ASCP Member
