## ABOUT THE AWARD

The Henry Nasrallah Award for Excellence in Clinical Psychopharmacology Education honors individuals who have made outstanding contributions in clinical psychopharmacology education and teaching. Established in 2025, this award recognizes educators whose work reflects Dr. Henry Nasrallah's legacy of advancing psychiatric knowledge through research, teaching, and mentorship. The recipient will receive a \$3,500 stipend including a \$2,500 honoraria and \$1,000 travel allowance. Attendance and presentation of a lecture at the 2026 ASCP Annual Meeting is expected for the awardee.
