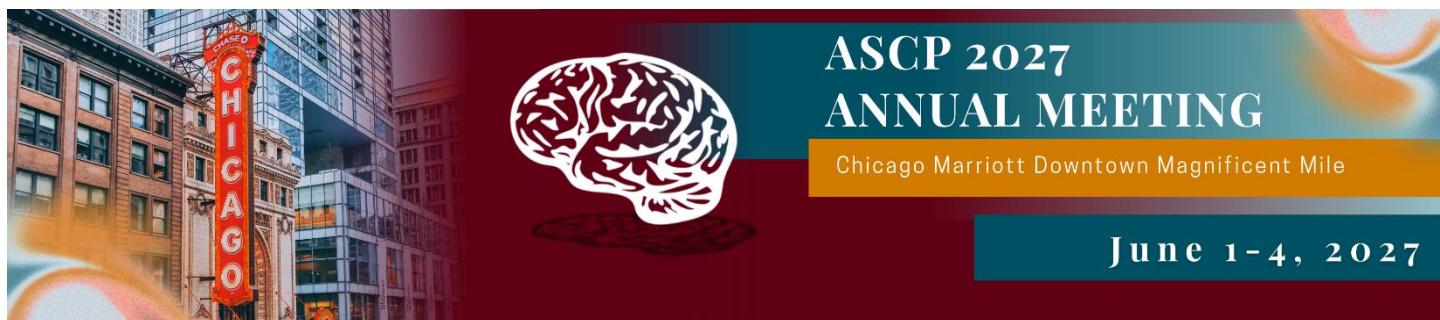




CALL FOR PROPOSALS

You are invited to participate in the Annual Meeting of the American Society of Clinical Psychopharmacology (ASCP) to be held at the Chicago Marriott Downtown Magnificent Mile on June 1 - 4, 2027, by submitting a proposal and attending the meeting. The committee welcomes submissions from the U.S. as well as international proposals, and this year the committee strongly encourages the composition of panels and workshops that include women, under-represented minorities and early career scientists and clinicians.

This year's meeting theme is

Beyond Symptom Reduction: Measuring What Matters in Psychiatry

Clinical trials have long relied on symptom scales as the primary benchmark of therapeutic success. Yet for patients, meaningful recovery extends far beyond symptom reduction, encompassing functional improvement, quality of life, and the ability to engage fully in work, relationships, and daily living. The Program Committee for the Annual Meeting is particularly interested in proposals that advance how we define, measure, and prioritize outcomes that are clinically meaningful and patient-centered, including functional endpoints, patient-reported outcomes, and novel frameworks that bridge the gap between clinical measurement and lived experience.

The Program Committee for the Annual Meeting also welcomes proposals addressing the full range of clinical psychiatry research and practice, including but not limited to the topics below:

- Artificial intelligence
- Biological models of psychiatric illness
- Career development and psychiatric workforce development, retention and wellbeing
- Clinical practice guidelines development and dissemination
- Clinical trials methodology
- Diverse practice contexts and methods
- Diverse populations
- Education related to psychopharmacology and psychiatric clinical trials
- Health systems research related to psychiatry
- Interactive effects of pharmacotherapy and psychotherapy
- Interventional psychiatry
- Neuromodulation
- Precision medicine approaches to psychiatric clinical trials or practice
- Psychopharmacology
- Use of clinical and real-world evidence in psychiatry

The ASCP Annual Meeting brings together over 1000 representatives from academia, the [National Institutes of Health \(NIH\)](#), [Food and Drug Administration \(FDA\)](#), European regulatory agencies and industry, including competitively selected New Investigator awardees. In recent years, the ASCP Annual Meeting focus has been expanded to address a number of timely issues relevant to clinical research in psychiatry, including the translation of research into practice, the importance of regulatory issues, and pharmacogenetics and other means to personalizing interventions. A Program Committee for the Annual Meeting chaired by Drs. Tiffany Farchione and Carlos Blanco with representation of the sectors that are part of the ASCP community lead the direction of the meeting.
