Description: The Psychiatric Neuroscience Center of Feinstein Institute for Medical Research is seeking a highly motivated Clinical Research Coordinator to join Dr. Hengyi Cao's team to work on an ongoing project combining neuroimaging and transcranial magnetic stimulation (TMS) to understand the cerebellar function in psychotic disorders. The individual will be responsible for the entire data collection procedures, including patient screening, acquisition of informed consent, schedule of research visits, conduction of neuroimaging scans, clinical assessments, and cognitive tests. The individual will also be responsible for data organization and maintaining the integrity and accuracy of the collected data. S/He will work closely with other clinical coordinators in the Center for necessary research trainings and getting incorporated into the overall research environment.

The individual will also have opportunity to learn skills in neuroimaging data analysis, and is encouraged to participate in analyzing the collected data and drafting manuscripts under the supervision of the principal investigator. This position is ideal for individuals who plan to gain clinical research experience in order to pursue a higher-level doctoral degree.

The Center is located at the Zucker Hillside Hospital, part of Northwell Health, the largest health care provider in the New York state. The hospital is one of the largest psychiatric facilities in Queens and the broad Long Island region, serving approximately five million residents in the area. The Center has accessibility to an extraordinary array of patient and treatment resources, and is equipped with state-of-the-art 3T Siemens Prisma scanner, highly powerful computing clusters, and other imaging and neuromodulation devices such as EEG, TMS, and ECT.
