

Poster Presentation & Mounting Requirements

- The maximum area per poster is 4 feet high by 4 feet wide and should be mounted at eye level.
- Place the poster title at the top of the poster board in 1" high letters.
- Please indicate the presenting author in the author block (bold, underline, asterisk, etc.).
- All disclosures relevant to this study must be listed on the poster.
- Remember, illustrations may be read by interested scientists from distances of about 3 feet or more.
 Keep them simple. Charts, drawings, and illustrations should be heavily drawn.
- Do not mount materials on heavy board because it will be difficult to affix the materials to the poster board. Keep presentation as lightweight as possible.
- Prepare and bring to the meeting all materials needed for the poster (figures, tables, etc.).
- Bring the necessary pushpins to mount the poster. The SOBP will have a limited supply of pushpins.
- You will be able to install your poster beginning at 7:00 AM on the day of your assigned session. Presenting authors are required to be at the board during the assigned poster session hours of 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Any posters left on the board or in the room at the conclusion of your session will be discarded.
- All poster presenters are required to register and pay the registration fee to attend and present your poster.
