Re: SOBP Annual Meeting Call for Proposals, May 16 - 18, 2019, Chicago, IL

The Program Committee is now requesting proposals for symposia for the 2019 Annual Meeting. While scientific quality is paramount, this year the committee will continue to strongly consider the composition of the symposia that include women, under-represented minorities and early career scientists and clinicians. Also, the committee is encouraging the submission of symposia on timely topics that coincide with the theme of the 2019 Annual Meeting: *Innovations in Clinical Neuroscience: Tools, Techniques and Transformative Frameworks*. The field of biological psychiatry is approaching a catalytic period for discovery. The purpose of the 2019 SOBP Annual meeting is to provide an interactive platform for learning and discovery. The meeting program will focus on alternative and transformative frameworks for understanding psychiatric illnesses, and present enhanced and newly emerging tools for measurement and manipulation. Within these frameworks and with these tools, techniques and experimental designs are illustrated that can enhance understanding of psychiatric illness and elucidate the biological pathways and markers of illness processes.
