- Symposia must include 1 chair who will present a 10-minute introduction to outline the goal of the session and 4 presenters who will have 25 minutes each, including a 20-minute presentation and a 5-minute discussion period.
- A co-chair is optional.
- All participants in a session must commit to registering for the meeting and to be available for all meeting days.
- No person can serve in more than 2 symposia sessions, regardless of their role in the session.
- Submissions that do not adhere to guidelines will not be reviewed.
