



MNRS Gerontological Nursing RIIG Student Research Publication Award

Purpose of the Award: The purpose of this award is to recognize a student member of the Gerontological Nursing RIIG who has produced an outstanding research publication related to gerontological nursing science.

Criteria for the Award:

- The nominee must be the first author of the publication.
- The manuscript must represent a significant contribution to the content area of gerontological nursing science.
- The manuscript must have been published within the last three years (2022-2025) or have been accepted for publication at the time of application for this award.
- Authors are allowed to self-nominate by submitting their own published articles for this award.

Eligibility Requirements:

- The nominee is a current student member of the Gerontological Nursing RIIG at the time of nomination.

Other Eligibility Considerations:

- Members may only apply for or be nominated for one RIIG award regardless of the number of RIIG memberships.
- Nominees must be active and engaged RIIG members as defined by the Gerontological Nursing RIIG.
- The awardee must be present to receive the award at the Gerontological Nursing RIIG Annual Business Meeting during the MNRS Annual Conference in St. Louis.
- The awardee will give a brief presentation (up to 10 minutes) of his or her research at the Gerontological Nursing RIIG Annual Business Meeting.

Submission Requirements:

- Current CV
- PDF copy of the nominated manuscript
- One paragraph statement from the nominee describing their contributions to the manuscript and how it advances gerontological nursing science

Notification and Presentation:

The RIIG Chair(s) will notify the award recipient via email. The awardee is strongly encouraged to be present at their RIIG 's Annual Business Meeting to receive the award and will be invited to give a brief presentation of their research/scholarship.
