



Poster Discussion Presentation Guidelines

- Poster Discussions are opportunities for the primary author to give a brief 3-minute synopsis of 1-3 key findings from the study.
- Presenters are asked to arrive at least 15 minutes before the start of their session to allow sufficient time to set up their posters and meet with the moderators.
- The poster boards will have pushpins presenters can use to affix their poster to the board.
 - The maximum poster size is **45 inches wide by 45 inches tall**.
- This 90-minute session is broken down as follows:
 - Begins with 30 minutes for general poster viewing
 - Then 60 minutes of moderated discussion
- Each poster discussion session consists of around 8 to 10 presentations.
- Each presenter is given a few minutes to present the key points of their poster and is asked a specific question or two by the moderator to begin the discussion.
