


Poster Guidelines:

Deadline EXTENDED TO October 20, 2023

- Poster Abstracts should be structured as: Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusion, and have a maximum of <u>250</u> words. Abstracts should include data.
- Posters should not be of a commercial or promotional nature.
- Abstract submitters in the following categories are eligible to also give a brief presentation during the poster talk session (please indicate if you wish to be considered). Abstracts selected for poster talks must also be presented as posters in the poster session.
 - Students currently enrolled in PhD, MD, or MD/PhD programs.
 - Postdoctoral fellows, medical residents, or junior faculty within 5 years of completing postdoctoral or residency training. Applicants may have a career development award (K-type) but may not be PI on a current or previous R-level grant (R03 and R36 grants permitted).
- All posters will be accepted unless otherwise notified.
- Eligible individuals who are selected for poster talks will be notified in late fall 2023.
- Poster dimensions will be available in late fall 2023.

Steps for Submission:

1. 
2. Click "Access My Dashboard"



3. Once logged into the portal, select the large blue square "Start a New Scientific Submission"



4. Select the submission type and fill out the required submission information.



Final Step: Select the yellow "Submit Abstract" button at the top.

- 1. You will receive a notification that the submission was submitted successfully.
- 2. You will receive an email confirmation of the submission.
- 3. You will be able to edit the submission until the submission period closes.
- 4. After the deadline has passed, all abstract submissions will be reviewed. Notifications will only be sent for abstracts not selected for presentation.
- 5. Eligible individuals who are selected to also present poster talks will be notified in late fall 2023.
