Poster Submissions

Submission Deadline: November 5, 2025

MPA is now accepting poster proposals for the 10th Biennial Molecular Psychiatry Meeting, which will take place March 29 – April 1, 2026 in Lihue, Hawaii on the island of Kauai.

GUIDELINES

- Poster Abstracts should be structured as: Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusion, and have a maximum of **250 words**. Abstracts should include data.
- Posters should not be of a commercial or promotional nature.
- Abstract submitters in the following categories are eligible to also give a brief presentation during the poster talk session (please indicate if you wish to be considered). Abstracts selected for poster talks must also be presented as posters in the poster session.
 - Students currently enrolled in PhD, MD, or MD/PhD programs.
 - Postdoctoral fellows, medical residents, or junior faculty within 5 years of completing postdoctoral or residency training. Applicants may have a career development award (K-type) but may not be PI on a current or previous R-level grant (R03 and R36 grants permitted).
- All posters will be accepted unless otherwise notified. Notifications will be sent in December.
- Only individuals selected for poster talks will be notified of acceptance in December.
- Poster dimensions and poster numbers will be emailed after the first of the year.


STEPS FOR SUBMISSION:

1. Visit the Abstract Submission Portal:

2. Click on the Submissions card and then “Access My Dashboard”



3. Once on your Dashboard, select the large blue square “Start a New Scientific Submission”



4. Select the submission type and fill out the required submission information.

Abstract Requirements:
Abstracts should not exceed 250 words.

Review your text for embedded formatting such as line breaks. (Please avoid copying from a PDF document)

Review your text for special characters to ensure they have copied over correctly.
