

ISBD-JSMD FUTURE LEADERS FELLOWSHIPS (LOCAL JAPANESE DELEGATES) DEADLINE FOR FUNDING: MAY 30TH 2025 (TBC)

To expand Japanese professionals' access to international research and education about bipolar disorders, the International Society for Bipolar Disorders (ISBD) and Japanese Society of Mood Disorders (JSMD) will collaborate to offer members of the JSMD fellowships that support attendance to the 27th Annual Conference of the ISBD. Applicants will be assessed based on submission of a formal application and personal statement, and there will be an an option to submit the application in Japanese. Priority will be given to professionals at an early stage of career development who demonstrate an interest in mood disorders research/clinical care. The selection process will be jointly overseen by JSMD leadership and members of the ISBD 2025 Conference Committee.

Fellowships will be awarded jointly by ISBD and JSMD and will cover the cost of registration fees to attend the meeting. No other travel support will be offered.

The Awards will be overseen by the 2025 Conference Committee and will be open to all early midcareer applicants seeking to attend the 27th Annual Conference of the ISBD. Applicants will be evaluated based on their submissions in conjunction with an overall assessment of the applicant as ascertained through submission of a CV, personal statement and optional letter of recommendation. In addition, these Awards are designed to address issues of equity and enhance access to the meeting, and hence, an additional dimension of assessment will be the perceived need for support to attend the meeting. In keeping with these principles, we will reserve 50% of the awards for those from Low and Middle-Income Countries, following World Bank Classifications.

These Awards will provide a fixed stipend to each awardee and are intended to cover most costs associated with attending the meeting, including travel, accommodation, and registration, as well as a plaque and a one-year membership in ISBD.
