INTERMEDIATE

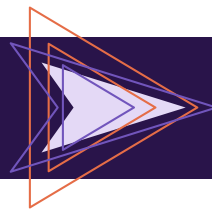
Those with some case management practice experience and familiarity with the culture. The individual may not yet be certified.

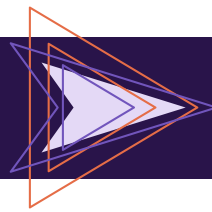
