



Expectations of Mentors:

1. Provide advice to mentee on research, clinical treatment, professional development, maximizing benefit of RSA membership and/or RSA meeting attendance.
2. Talk by phone or video chat with mentee at least once prior to the annual RSA meeting though the extended period before the meeting allows for more than one meeting and/or email exchanges.
3. Meet with mentee at the Mentorship Meetup or at another point during the meeting.
4. Attend your mentee's poster or symposium presentation at the meeting, if they have one.
5. Make efforts to connect mentee with colleagues/RSA members who are relevant to their research and/or clinical interests.
6. Continued communication with mentee after the meeting is encouraged but not a requirement.
7. Review the presentation entitled "[Mentoring First-Generation and Early-Career Scientists of Color](#)" that will be shared with all mentors in the program and read one or more sources on mentoring listed on the RSA website: <https://researchsocietyonalcohol.org/resources> These may form the basis for discussion with your mentee.
