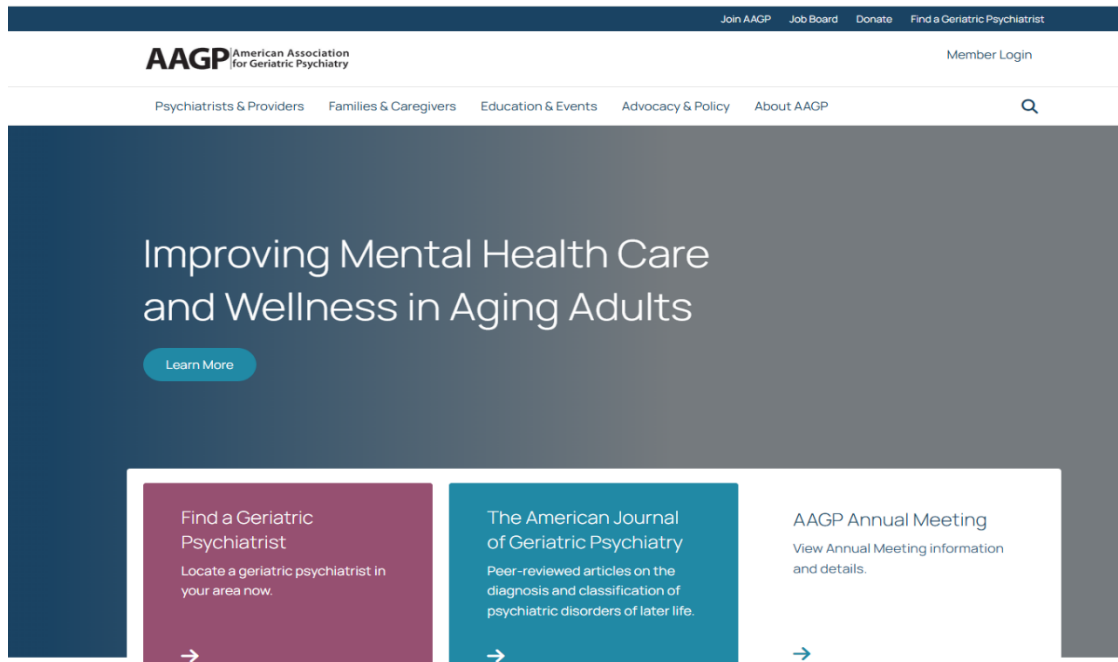
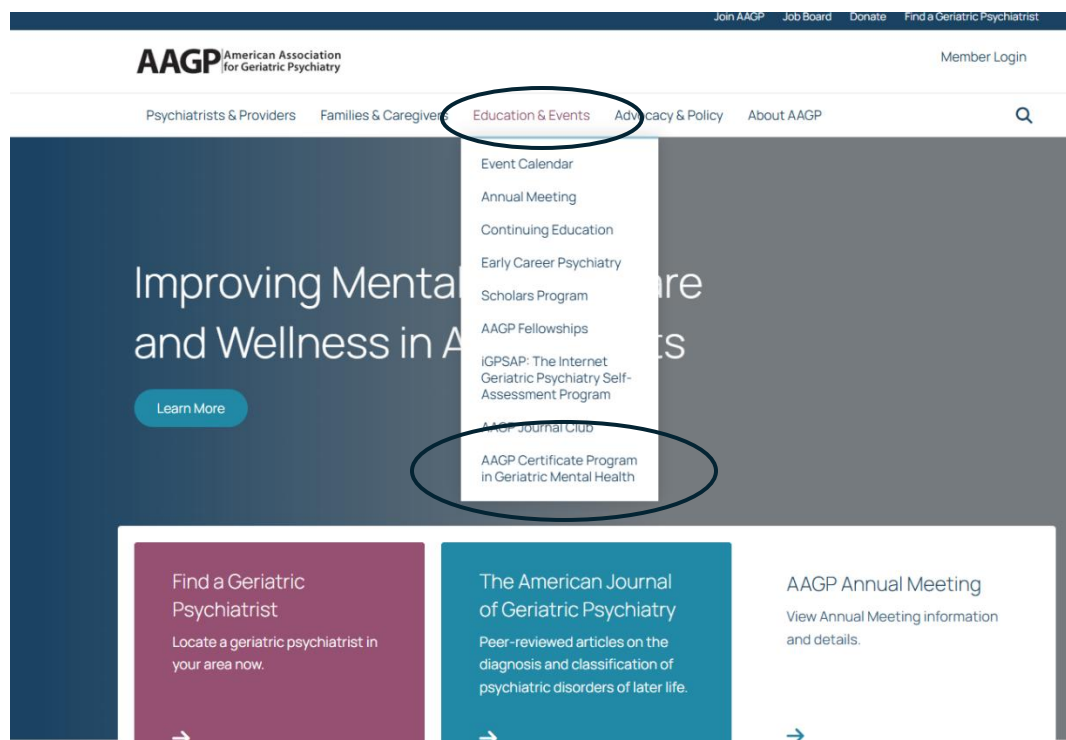

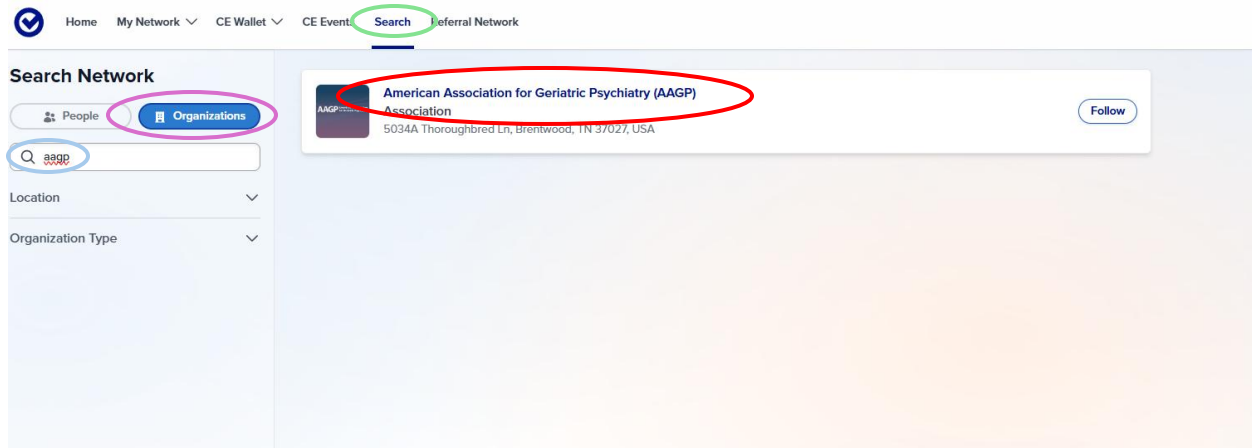
Hover over the “Education and Events” link. Click on the last subject in the drop-down menu: “AAGP Certificate Program in Geriatric Mental Health”



If you are not already logged into your active AAGP member account, do so at this time using this link: <https://aagponline.app.neoncrm.com/>

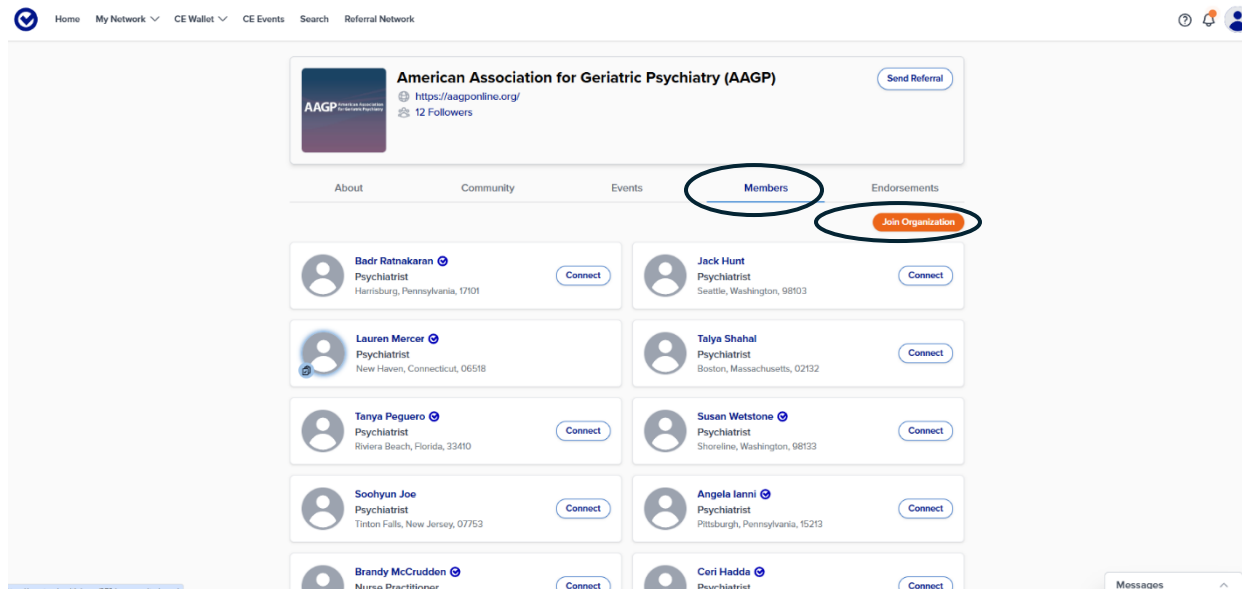
You must have an active account with TPN.health to register for the Certificate Program. Go to <https://tqn.health/> to sign in or create an account.

Once you have established an account with TPN.health, you will need to link your account to the AAGP community. From the TPN dashboard, click on:




1. Click **Search**
